Location and Parking:

Baseline Data Services is located at: 2601 Metropolis Parkway, Suite 100, Plainfield, IN 46168, just south of US 40 along Perry Road. Parking is located along the front of the building, as is the main entrance. There is parking along the back and sides of the building, but you must enter the main entrance. Baseline is the office immediately to the right after entering the building.
